

Intensive Care Fellow/Senior Registrar 2016

University Hospital Geelong, Barwon Health, is seeking an ICU Fellow or Senior Registrar to work in the Intensive Care Unit. Positions are for 12 months (commencing February 1st 2016) or 6 months (commencing February 1st 2016 or August 1st 2016).

- Applicants must be registered or eligible for registration with the Australian Health Practitioners Regulatory Authority (AHPRA)
- Ideally the applicants will have passed the CICM fellowship exam, or hold a fellowship in another specialty and have appropriate ICU experience
- Consideration will be given to candidates without the CICM fellowship exam, but who are planning on undertaking this early in 2016, and have suitable clinical experience

University Hospital Geelong is a 406 bed regional tertiary academic hospital located in Coastal South West Victoria, one hour from Melbourne.

The 24 bed ICU has over 1500 admissions a year, with a mix of adult cardiothoracic (including ECMO), medical, surgical patients and paediatric patients. There is an opportunity to engage in non-clinical activities to further professional development during rostered hours. Funding may be available to support continuing professional development at the discretion of the Department.

Our Department has an established research department, a strong commitment to teaching including echocardiography teaching and a number of simulation sessions per year. We have a 100% pass rate for trainees undertaking CICM Fellowship examination.
