



Want the chance to gain consultant experience whilst a registrar?

Redcliffe ICU has a transition year position available from February 2021. The position meets the transition year requirement for the College of Intensive Care Medicine and has been approved by the College (<https://cicm.org.au/Trainees/Transition-Year-Training#QLD>). It involves a mix of both clinical and non-clinical activities. The successful applicant will be able to choose between either echocardiography or education for their non-clinical focus.

You will act as a "junior consultant" with responsibility for direct patient care.

The successful applicant needs to meet the requirements for transition year as per the college regulations ([https://cicm.org.au/CICM_Media/CICMSite/CICM-Website/Resources/Professional%20Documents/C-Gen-\(2020\)-Regulations.pdf](https://cicm.org.au/CICM_Media/CICMSite/CICM-Website/Resources/Professional%20Documents/C-Gen-(2020)-Regulations.pdf)). Trainees who are sitting the fellowship exam in September/October 2020 and have met the other requirements for transition year are able to apply.

Unit Snapshot

- CICM accredited Limited G6 and transition year unit
- 7 ventilator equivalent beds with over 550 admissions per year. There is a mixed of adult medical and surgical patients
- Paediatric patients are admitted. The majority of admitted paediatric patients remain within the unit. The remainder are admitted whilst awaiting retrieval to Queensland Children's Hospital
- Staffed with dynamic CICM Intensivists supported by registrars
- Member of ANZICS Clinical Trial Group, currently recruiting to BLING III and PLUS
- Local research includes EuroBact. Local investigator research is supported
- Strong educational commitment with weekly registrar teaching sessions, active input into state-wide intensive care and hospital teaching programmes
- Attendance at weekly senior registrar teaching sessions in Brisbane or an alternative regular educational session encouraged. Additional CPD time for courses and conferences can be negotiated
- Rostered hours are 76 hours per fortnight in a mixed shift / on-call roster, with 1:5 commitment for evenings and weekends. Appropriate consultant support will be available out of hours
- Transition year trainees do first on-call from home with consultant backup
- Local accommodation will be provided if required during on-call and Queensland Health on call allowances and penalty rates will apply.

Redcliffe is a coastal residential city located on the northern outskirts of greater Brisbane. Other requirements:

- Applicants must be registered with, or eligible for registration with AHPRA
- Applicants must meet the requirements for transition year training (if post 2014 training) or be post fellowship examination (if pre 2014 training)
